



**INTERARTIVE PUBLISHING GUIDELINES:
Call Art & Copyright
Artworks and Artistic Projects**

General Considerations:

- The material intended for publication in InterArtive should be sent to [info\[at\]interartive.org](mailto:info[at]interartive.org) as an attachment in the **format of a Word document** (.doc o docx). It should include artist's name and surname and a brief description of his/her activities (100 words max.)
- Languages: The text should be in **Spanish and/or English**. If the author's native language is none of the above, he/she can send the text in their native language with a translation in Spanish and(or English).
- Deadline: 10th February 2013.
- License: The texts are uploaded under Creative Commons, following guidelines to ensure the integrity of the article and the author's confidence. Therefore, the rights of the author are respected, while at the same time the created knowledge can be shared online.

Specific Guidelines:

The artistic proposals about Art & Copyright will be considered for publication in the format of Virtual Gallery, presented through a gallery of images or videos with a brief text that introduces the visitors to the work presented. It can be focused on a single work or project or on series of works.

The proposal should be sent as following:

- Word document stating:
 - Title of the Gallery or work.
 - Text: Maximum length: 500 words.
If footnotes are included: Insert Endnotes. Format: [1], [2], [3]....
 - List of titles of pictures – Captions. Each image must be identified with the same name as the attachment for each one (see next item).

- Images (as separate files in .jpg or .png) or videos (link or embed code):
 - Up to 10 images/videos, optimized for web.
 - Can be: Various images of the same work or different works, belonging or not to the same series
